### ***¿Qué estamos haciendo en artes de lenguaje en español?***

En artes de lenguaje comenzamos a leer *Esperanza renace* un cuento que tomo lugar en 1930 durante la depresión. Es de una familia que migra a los EE.UU. En la gramática continuaremos aprendiendo sobre las reglas de los acentos. En la escritura continuaremos escribiendo un ensayo de un narrativo personal.



### ***What are we doing in Spanish Language Arts?***

In Spanish Language Arts we started reading *Esperanza Renace* a story that takes place in the 1930's depression era. It is about a family that has to migrate to the US. In grammar we will continue to learn about the accent rules. For writing, we will continue to focus on a Personal Narrative Essav.

### ***What are we doing in English Language Arts?***

In English Language Arts, began reading the novel *Hatchet*, which talks about a thirteen-year-old boy who is traveling to Canada to spend the summer with his dad. The plane crashes in the Canadian wilderness and Brian needs to find a way to survive. We will continue to focus on the various aspects of literature and literary devices (metaphors, similes, hyperbole, etc.). In grammar we will continue to focus on learning roots, suffixes, prefixes and their meaning.
