Monthly Project:

This month your child is to create a book parade float out of a shoebox. (See examples below)

1. Pick your favorite book
2. Cover the box.
3. Put items that represent the book on top.
4. Write the name of the title and author on one side of the box.
5. Write your name on the other side of the box.
6. Attach a string long enough for your child to stand and pull the book float.

Students must be ready to present their project to the class in Spanish and explain the book's main idea and 2 key details. We will have a parade as well.

This month we will be learning about:

Language Arts

Reading: (Spanish) We will begin Unit 6, in our Adelante curriculum. The theme is, "Stories offer us life lessons". The theme question is, "What can we learn from mistakes?" We will compare and contrast two literature books.

Writing: (Spanish) We will continue working on opinion paragraphs. Students will write one paragraph to persuade readers as to why a certain holiday is the best using their opinions and reasons.

Math: (Spanish) We will finish up with module 2 place value through addition and subtraction to 20. We will begin engage math curriculum Module 3: Indirect comparison in length measurement.

Social Studies/Science: (English) Our focus this month will be in social studies. We will begin Unit 5: The people of our world. Vocabulary: Culture, tradition, history, immigrant and customs.
