This month's project will focus on places in the community. Students must choose a place and worker in the community (post office-mailman, school-principal, library-librarian, etc) and write 2-3 sentences in Spanish to describe the location and the worker they have selected. Students must create a poster on 8.5x11 to present to the class. Projects will be presented in Spanish.

This month we will be learning about:

Language Arts (Spanish): Reading: Benchmark Adelante Curriculum. We will be learning about the community, rules, laws, and the characteristics of a good citizen. Writing: We will begin working on the Descriptive Genre. Students will go through the writing process to develop a writing piece about a place in the community.

Math (Spanish): Engage NY Math Curriculum. Students will be working on Module 5 Geometry– identifying, comparing and partitioning shapes and Module 1 –Addition and Subtraction. Students will be using 3 dimensional shapes to create and compose new shapes and will also learn various strategies for addition and subtraction.

Science (English): Earth Science: This month we will be working on our unit on plants. Students will be learning key features of plants, functions and their habitats.
