Language Arts (Spanish)

Writing: We will continue practicing the narrative writing genre. The students will write about a personal experience in a special place they have visited in a 5-sentence paragraph.

Math: The students will be developing concepts such as positional value, comparing numbers, and addition and subtraction to 40. We will continue working on Module 4 from our math curriculum: Engage NY.

Science: We will continue learning about the Sun, the Moon, the stars, and how patterns in the sky affect our days, nights, and seasons.
